## Saline Rowing Points Guideline

Saline Rowing is a self-funded club sport. Beyond dues, the team / club requires family participation for the continued success of student-athletes on and off the water. A successful team is not just winning races, it's also the combined support and leadership of the club families through shared contributions / volunteering.

Saline Rowing establishes the following criteria for volunteering opportunities / requirements for all family members of the team. Regatta support and Fundraising are critical elements for the success of the team, and continuing its legacy.

Each Family must earn 300 points each Season – Fall & Spring. Points earned in one season do not carry over into the following season. While no points are provided during the Winter & Summer off-seasons, team support as needed is appreciated.

Families earn points by participating in Fundraising and other support activities. Families who earn less than 300 points, are assessed \$2.00 / point below the 300 point threshold, and payment is due before their athlete can participate in subsequent seasons. Families agree to abide by these participation guidelines when paying dues.

The Saline Rowing Team is unable to operate without adequate financial status. Each family is required to participate in at least 50% of all Fundraisers that require physical volunteers. Fundraisers such as Grocery Scrip programs, Restaurant profit sharing, etc.. are not included in the participation requirement. Failure to meet the 50% requirement shall result in a deduction of 150 points for each Fundraiser below the 50% participation threshold.

For Example: There are 4 Fundraisers. 2 Fundraisers represent the minimum participation requirement. A Family earns 100 points for only 1 Fundraiser, and fails to participate in a second fundraiser. The family's Fundraising net points is -50.

Fundraising points are assigned as follows per Fundraising event:

1 point per each \$1.00 of team profit for sales. Ex: Mum sales, Discount Cards, etc...

50 points per family for Fundraising time of 3 hours or less

100 points per family for Fundraising time of 3 to 6 hours

150 points per family for Fundraising time of 6 hours or more

200 points for organizing and executing any Fundraiser that generates at least \$500 in profit for the team.

Mandatory Rower Fundraisers, such as the Saline Craft Show, are not included as part of points accumulation.

In general, volunteering earns approximately 10 points / hour. Points may be awarded for support activities not specifically mentioned here, with the consent of a majority of the voting Board members.

Points will be announced in emails soliciting volunteers, and some activities will not necessarily award points.
